Teachers

Pre-requirements

For having access to University, the EBAU exam has to be done.

You also need to come from the Baccalaureate years or from the Superior Technical Training.

Teaching studies: bachelor

- 4 years. Studies in:
- Early Childhood Ed.
- Primary Ed.

Able to teach in courses from 0-6 (early childhood ed.) and from 6-12 (primary ed.)

Once the Degree is finished, you are already a teacher, without the need of a Master.



How to access the labor market:

Public sector: you can access it if, once you have the Degree, you take a national examination (Oposiciones).

Private sector: you only need the Degree + the institution's requirements.

Specialization of teachers

When having finished the Degree, you can teach almost any subject.

However, you can specialize in a specific subject or educational field (Music, Languages, Sport, Therapeutic Pedagogy, Language and Audition...).

To teach Languages, the C1 level is required. To teach Religion, the DECA (Declaración Eclesiástica de Competencia Académica) is required.

For Secondary Education teachers...

It is completely different. You need: a Bachelor Degree that specializes you in one specific subject (e.g., Biology) + Master for Secondary Education Teaching.
