Programme objectives:

The programme aims to prepare student teachers from the TEFE (Teachers of English for Future Europe) consortium for an international teaching practice (ITP) experience and engages teacher educators in integrating ITP into teacher education study programmes.

About the Programme:

"Teachers of English for Future Europe: Experience Teaching Practice Internationally" is a foundational TEFE BIP International Teaching Practice Induction Programme. It offers an opportunity for aspiring student teachers and teacher educators to prepare for international teaching practice experience in TEFE consortium countries. In this instance, participants gain experience of Czech primary and secondary school education. The programme is delivered as part of the three-year Erasmus+ Cooperative Partnership project: Teachers of English for Future Europe – Putting the Internationalisation of Teaching Practice into Action (2023-1-CZ01-KA220-HED-000161134). Programme highlights include: an introduction to the TEFE A+ project consortium, collaboration in trans-national teacher groups, school visits and observations to experience teaching practice internationally, and the advancement of mobility and employability skills for future teachers of English.

















Programme delivery:

Developed by the TEFE consortium, the programme is hosted annually by one of the TEFE consortium countries. It includes a two-day online component and a five-day physical event. The preparatory online seminar/ workshop establishes connections across the trans-national student teachers' groups, introduces the <u>TEFE Methodology</u>, and provides an initial introduction to the internationalisation of teaching practice. The five-day face-to-face induction programme immerses participants in an international teaching environment, utilising the <u>TEFE Framework</u> and the International Teaching Practice Toolkit. This is then followed by the final day of the online component, designed to provide participants with feedback, assess programme outcomes, and provide an opportunity for students' final presentations.

Teaching and mentoring provision:

The academic provision of teaching, mentoring and induction of student teachers is delivered collaboratively by staff recruited from across the consortium institutions. This way each TEFE BIP programme facilitates the growing body of international teaching practice knowledge and experiences, it also continuously expands the TEFE professional community membership base.

Expected Learning/Training Outcomes:

- 1. **Comprehensive Understanding:** Participants will gain a comprehensive understanding of the TEFE Framework, the International Teaching Practice Toolkit, and the broader context of international education.
- 2. Enhanced Teaching Skills: Exposure to diverse teaching environments will enhance participants' teaching skills, equipping them with the ability to navigate cultural nuances and adapt their teaching methods effectively.

Global Perspective: The programme aims to foster a global perspective among participants, encouraging an appreciation for cultural diversity and a commitment to international collaboration in education.
